

Country Groups

Students will be broken up into 6 groups. Each group represents the six countries for the AP Comparative Government curriculum: Great Britain (UK), Mexico, Russia, China, Nigeria, and Iran. Country groups are responsible for all of the following on designated days in which the country is studied

Country groups are responsible for providing review material for said country. Review material MUST include the following:

- 15 True/False questions – to be presented in a Kahoot!
- 25 Multiple Choice questions – to be presented in a Kahoot!
- 2 Free Response questions – to be presented on a Powerpoint on 2 different slides
- Questions should be written at an AP level and should be the original work of students – some may be basic/straight forward information, but grade will greatly be based on higher-level questions. The questions must be answerable, and the distractors must be reasonable. It is easy to find this stuff online – PLEASE DON'T – it becomes really obvious when students are standing in front of other students and can't even pronounce the words on the slide "they created."
- There are ~5-6 people in every group so I suggest you split the work accordingly and assign 1-2 people to compile all of the work into the final product.

In addition to the trivia/review questions, each country should prepare a soundtrack of sorts to play in the background during the trivia review/feast. This can simply be going onto Spotify, or creating a group of songs of your own.

- Some examples include:
 - UK – The Beatles, The Rolling Stones, Elton John, The Spice Girls, Adele, etc.
 - Russia – classical composers like Tchaikovsky or more modern trends
 - Nigeria – Afrobeats (look it up)
 - China – *Mulan* soundtrack...

Student groups are responsible for bringing in **country specific food** on the assigned day. Items need to be native to country discussed OR themed around country discussed.

- Items include: hot and/or cold entrees (bought or home cooked), drinks, snack foods, desserts/candies, plates, utensils, napkins, cups. If a group member fails to bring in an assigned item then the group member will LOSE the CURVE on the exam for that country.

Student groups are responsible for showing up EARLY on the day of presentation to set up the food/Kahoot before your classmate arrive/the bell rings.
